Enhancing Green Space in Moor Nook

Following feedback from tenants in Moor Nook, we have cleared overgrown planters on Burholme Close. The communal space had previously served as an allotment for tenants on the close, with a history of winning awards for its presentation and condition.

Over time, the space has become increasingly difficult to maintain, with the greenery becoming a trip hazard and growing into tenants' gardens.

Our GreenCare Team have since taken on the greenspace and will maintain the area, with plans for our charitable subsidiary Preston Vocational Centre to install additional planters.

Be in our photos!


We are looking for tenants to be featured in photos, this could be just you, you and your family, or you with other household members. Photos can be taken in your home or out and about in your community.
